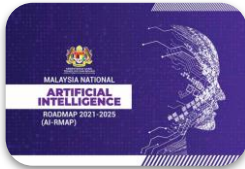

# The Future of Malaysia's AI Governance

Building multi-stakeholder dialogue platform



## Key Findings:

1. The interpretation of **AI Safety to local contexts** ranking highest among challenges identified.
1. This is followed by the **need for clarity around accountability mechanisms** with the possibility of setting up an institution who could impose accountability and mete punishments.
1. Fragmentation in communication and synergy across sectors and agencies challenges unified approaches to building a safe AI environment.
1. Last of highly ranked challenges include **complexity in regulating data to address challenges such as fraud**.



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
